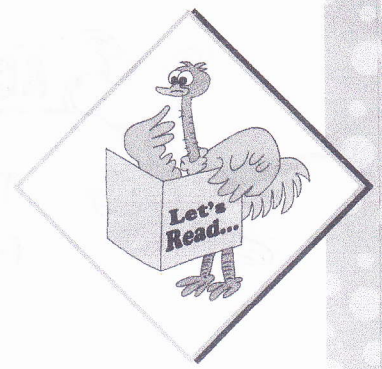


18 OCCUPATIONS

Occupation	Work
accountant	keeps and examines business accounts
acrobat	performs daring tricks and stunts, especially in a circus
archaeologist	studies the societies and peoples of the past by examining the remains of their buildings, tools and other objects
architect	designs and draws plans for buildings
astronaut	a person who travels in a spacecraft
author	writes books
bus conductor	collects bus fares from passengers
butcher	sells meat
carpenter	makes furniture
chauffeur	employed to drive a motor car
chef	a cook in a restaurant or a hotel
cobbler	makes or mends shoes
composer	writes music, especially classical music
curator	takes charge of a museum or an art gallery
decorator	decorates houses
dentist	examines and treats people's teeth
detective	finds out what has happened in a crime or other situation and find the people involved
electrician	installs and repairs electrical equipment
engineer	uses scientific knowledge to design, construct and maintain engines and machines or structures such as roads, railways and bridges
explorer	travels to places about which very little is known, in order to discover what is there
fishmonger	sells fish
florist	sells flowers
grocer	sells food such as flour, sugar and tinned foods
inventor	creates or designs new things
journalist	writes for a newspaper

lawyer	advises people about the law and represents them in court
locksmith	makes and mends locks
mechanic	repairs and maintains machines and engines, especially car engines
musician	skilled at playing one or more than one musical instrument
optician	tests people's eyesight and sells spectacles or contact lenses
photographer	takes photographs of people and things
plumber	fixes and repairs taps and pipes
poet	writes poems
reporter	writes for the newspapers or television
scientist	does research in science
sculptor	carves in stone, clay, wood, etc
shepherd	looks after sheep
seamstress	a woman who sews and makes clothes as her job
surgeon	a doctor who treats and operates on sick people
tailor	sews and makes clothes for men
umpire	makes sure that a sports match or contest is played fairly and that the rules are not broken
usher	shows people to their seats in theatres and cinemas
veterinarian	treats sick or injured animals
zookeeper	looks after the animals in a zoo

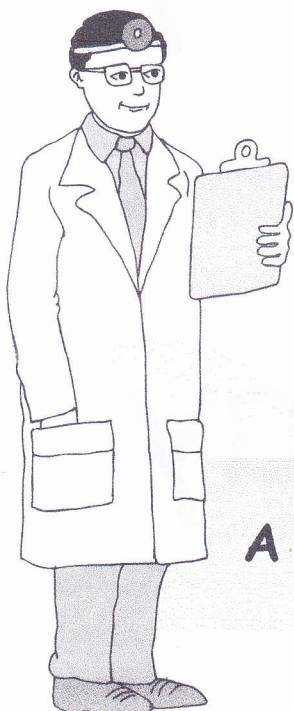

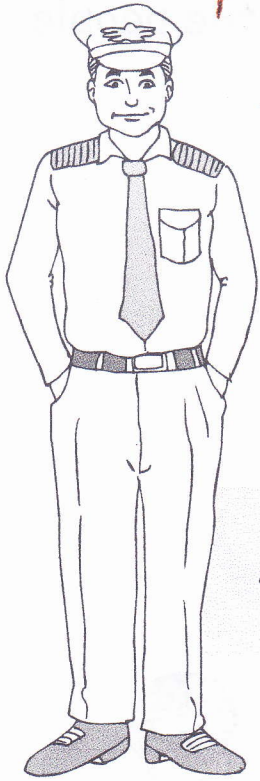


A teacher teaches in a school.

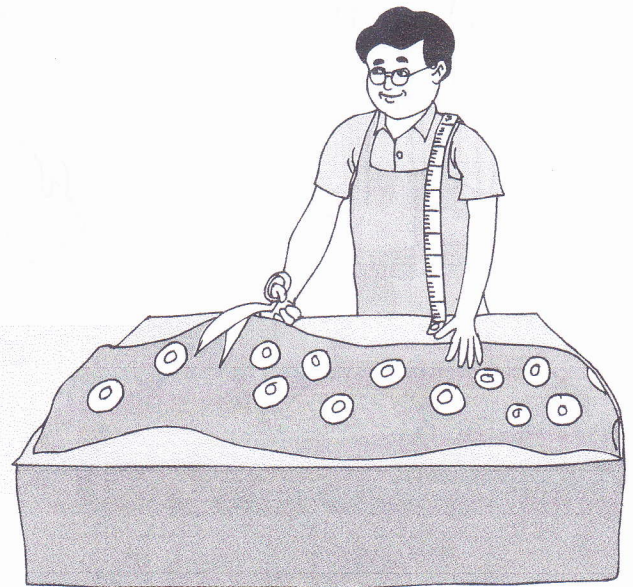


A doctor cures his patient.

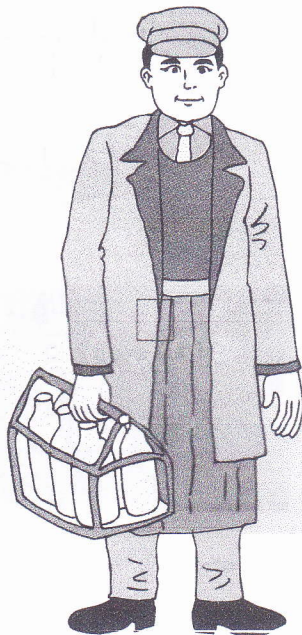

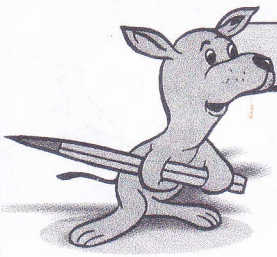


A musician composes music.
